#### **Hamburg strengthens trade ties with Asia**

Hamburg's exports increased 2.5 times from 2003 to 2023, with exports to Asia surpassing those to Europe. The proportion of goods exported to other European countries declined significantly. Hamburg imported goods worth EUR 74.2 billion in 2023, almost doubling the amount imported in 2003.



#### Women champion sustainability in Hamburg

More Hamburg-based women are leading sustainable startups than in traditional companies, according to the Green Startup Monitor 2024 by the Borderstep Institute and Startup Association. Of the top jobs in sustainable startups, 24% were held by women, compared to just 17% in traditional companies!



### Hamburg gears up for the Port Anniversary

The Port of Hamburg is all set to celebrate its 835<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration from 9-12 May. The port would welcome over 250 ships into its waters, besides hosting an array of activities including guided tours, exhibitions, cultural highlights, and more!

One such player is the Logistik-Initiative Hamburg Management GmbH (LIHH), an industry network that brings together logistics companies and institutions in Hamburg. With a cohort of climate-conscious member companies in its network, the LIHH has tapped into exploring growth and cooperation especially in harnessing green hydrogen and championing energy transition in Hamburg. #### A Glimpse into Hamburg's Research Landscape

Hamburg is home to a plethora of institutions dedicated to various topics such as science, technology, innovation, culture, sustainability and research. In addition to its thriving academic science centers, Hamburg boasts a diverse array of research institutions spanning private enterprises, state-funded organizations, and non-academic research facilities. The DESY (Deutsches Elektronen-Synchrotron) is one such publicly funded facility that is publicly funded by the state of Hamburg and Germany. Research has also branched into life sciences, a primary example of which is the Life Science Nord, the regional industry cluster for medical technology, and pharmaceutical sciences in Hamburg and north Germany. Research has also forayed into the logistics sector, with the Fraunhofer Center for Maritime Logistics and Services (CML), a research institute that develops and implements solutions tailored to the needs of the maritime sector. #### **International Maritime Museum of Hamburg**



The International Maritime Museum of Hamburg is a museum that showcases the personal collection of Peter Tamm (1928-2016), who was an avid collector of all things related to maritime history. The museum takes an interactive approach, offering its visitors the opportunity to navigate through each telling a unique story through artefacts. Visitors are encouraged to start exploring at the top and work their way back down to the ground level, as recommended by Peter Tamm himself. Located in the

historic Kaispeicher B, the collection was maintained by the esteemed Peter Tamm Sen Foundation.

Opened in 2008, this museum in HafenCity Hamburg spans nine levels, and is home to over 1 million pictures, 100,000 books, 38,000 miniature ships, and more!
