Hamburg as a Food Location

On October 10, 2023, the Senate granted approval for the creation of a new food cluster aimed at strengthening Hamburg's prominence within the European food industry. The Senate is making proactive investments in the city's food start-up ecosystem to foster innovation.







Emission Free Shipping on Lake Alster

As part of the "E-Mobility on the Alster" project, emission-free shipping on Lake Alster will take effect in November. All vessels shall be converted to green engines. Climate-neutral shipping on the Elbe tributary is expected to save 900 metric tons of C02 per year.

Hamburg's Economic Downturn

An increasing number of Hamburg-based companies find themselves grappling with the ongoing economic downturn. The most significant concern, affecting 65.2 percent of them, is the scarcity of skilled labor, closely followed by weakening domestic demand and soaring energy prices.

Port of Hamburg Adjusts Fees for 2024

Owing to persistent inflation, the Hamburg Port Authority (HPA) will raise port fees by an average of 6.5 percent from January 01, 2024. Port authorities have deemed this adjustment essential to continue the provision of efficient infrastructure.

HAMBURG INSIGHT



The last remaining ensemble of traditional Hamburg architecture can be found in the **Deichstrasse**, where the old Hamburg townhouses grace the banks of the Nikolai Canal. Right next to the historic Speicherstadt, the tall and narrow houses of Deichstrasse resemble Amsterdam's architecture, originating from the 17th through the 19th century. In those times, large parts of Hamburg's city center looked like today's Deichstrasse.



As soon as one enters Deichstrasse, the atmosphere suddenly changes. There is no longer any trace of the cool flair of modern office buildings in the immediate vicinity. Here, quaint cafés, charming restaurants and small boutiques beckon visitors to savor the ambience of old Hamburg. Narrow alleys alongside these townhouses provide access to the waterfront. The Nikolai Canal, connecting the Alster with the harbor docks on the river Elbe, once served as the political and economic center of Hamburg in old times. The merchants living there used the canal for goods trade.

But a catastrophic event in 1842 forever altered the cityscape: **the Great Fire**! It was in one of these houses, now converted into a restaurant, that the devastating fire broke out. Despite significant efforts, it took three and a half days to finally bring the raging flames under control. Furthermore, the Second World War also left an indelible mark on the city center. Through extensive efforts in the 1970s, the houses were able to be restored. The old and simple townhouses, standing in rather stark contrast to the pompous facades of modernity, serve as a reminder of the days gone by. Deichstrasse is an essential destination for all tourists visiting Hamburg, a place where the essence of the city's history and charm is elegantly preserved. For more information, click <u>here</u>.
