

India's car market in the fast lane

Critical Minerals Mission: India's \$4 billion effort to become future-ready amid global tech war

After a brief pause, heavy monsoon rains swept across Maharashtra starting 13th June, Friday, with Mumbai also experiencing a resurgence of monsoon showers. Mumbai's Santacruz observatory logged 19 mm rainfall between 14th June, Saturday and 15th June, Sunday morning,

while the Colaba coastal observatory recorded 34 mm rainfall.



India budget: Fiscal deficit, slowing growth challenge

India is facing economic challenges, including a widening fiscal deficit and slowing growth, with the fiscal deficit reaching 46.5% of the FY25 target. The government is under pressure to stimulate the economy through measures such as income tax cuts and increased spending on infrastructure and rural

development, while balancing the need for fiscal consolidation.
